

Maths focus: Fractions, Decimals, Money and Time, and Geometry

- This term we will finish off looking at fractions before moving onto decimals and a short unit on money and time.
- We will then look at Geometry by delving into shapes and angles, followed by plotting their position on a grid using co-ordinates.

Science: Light and Mixtures and separating them

In the first half term, we will be finishing off Animals, Skeletons and Movement before moving onto light where we will investigate a light's source and what light does when it hits different materials.

In the latter topic, we will investigate what mixtures are and how can they be separated, by looking at the different characteristics of substances and how they dissolve.

Supporting Learning:

Again, nature walks are a good opportunity to talk about the sun and other light sources. Think about the different materials in the area and how light shines and reflects on and/or through them, or even how it doesn't!

When you are cooking dinner, you could invite your child to help and/or watch. You could discuss the different substances you use, such as salt or sugar, and talk about how they dissolve into water/other mixtures.

English focus: Instruction

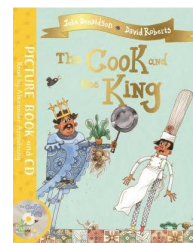
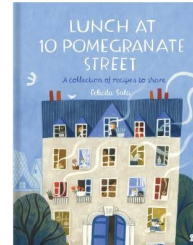
