#### Ideas to share at home:

Thread a needle and practice use a range of stitches to join fabric pieces.

# <u>Science:We begin by looking at the human Circulatory</u> system.

Key vocabulary to discuss: Circulatory system: heart, lungs, veins, arteries, blood cells.

The children will look at the impact of lifestyle on the body thinking about the effects of diet, drugs and exercise.

We will then create a balanced menu for an afternoon tea which is the cooking part of Design technology.

#### Ideas to share at home:

- Discuss and practise how to find your pulsethis would be very helpful.
- Discuss the lifestyle choices that you make.
- Look at where the food we eat comes from.
- Cook and bake together using measuring equipment.
