#### **Pupil Premium**

You only need to do this once and it will last for the duration of your child's time at their current school. This will ensure that our school and the children we serve are as well funded as possible.

# **Online safety**

Managing children's access to technology can be very challenging. It is not always possible to deny children access to technology in order to keep them safe since it is central aspect of our lives. Best practise to help guide children through the world of technology is through honest and open conversations and supervision.



To help supervise your child on their devices (particularly smartphone devices) there is an app that you can use to help you do this. The app is called MMGuardian and is designed to help you monitor your child's activity including online activity and messages/pictures sent. Al programs are used to track key words and send you notifications should there be any concerns you need to be aware about. Just for your information, a reminder about age ratings on social media apps. Most apps have an age limit of 13+ including TikTok, Youtube, Instagram and Whatsapp has an age rating of 16+. It is advisable that children should not have their own accounts on these sites (perhaps being linked to another account where possible) in order to keep them safe from inappropriate content and the possibility of encountering bullying or hateful comments.
